

Peter Perreault Student/Athlete Of The Year Scholarship Award



Peter W. Perreault was a 1957 graduate of Shrewsbury High School.

While at SHS, Peter played football, basketball and rowed on the high school crew.

Peter attended Cheshire Academy as a post-graduate student-athlete for one year before entering Boston University. At B. U. he excelled in football and captained the team in his senior year. He was drafted by the Pittsburgh Steelers professional football team and was traded one year later to the New York Jets organization where he played guard and back-up center for eight years. He retired after playing for the Minnesota Vikings for two years. In 1991 he was inducted into the Shrewsbury High School Athletic Hall of Fame. Peter passed away in 2001. His family and many friends have established this student/athlete scholarship award in his name.
