I. On the first page of your application, please include the following information:

1. Applicant's full name
2. Home Address and telephone number
3. Email Address (we will contact you via email if you are missing anything from your application)
4. College you plan to attend and intended major (if you are still undecided, please let us know where you have applied and/or been accepted, and what you are leaning toward).
5. Names of relatives who have graduated from Shrewsbury High School or Major Howard Beal Memorial High School (Include relationship to applicant and year of graduation).

II. Respond briefly to each of the following (3-5 sentences each):

1. What are your hopes and dreams for the next four years?
2. Please tell us how a SHS faculty member or coach has made a difference in your life and/or has helped you to be successful at SHS.

III. Include an essay to tell us how you have positively impacted life at SHS through your citizenship and/or your involvement in extra-curricular life.

IV. Please also include with your application:

- A list of extra-curricular activities and offices held as well as awards received during the last four years. Include involvement with school, religious groups and community. List number of years involved.
- Teacher or advisor recommendation (a college recommendation letter is fine).

The Class of 1976 Scholarships will be presented at the SHS Alumni Association Scholarship Presentation in May. The scholarship recipient will be notified by mail on or around April 22<sup>nd</sup>.
